N.V. Champagne Brut 'Carte Blanche' Bernard Remy, France	10.75	53

A family-run House situated in the small town of Allement, nestled on the edge of the famous Côte des Blancs. Bernard Remy bought his first vines in 1968 and has built a great reputation over the last 60 years, first domestically and now on the international scene too. Their 'Carte Blanche' is a Pinot-led blend with an intense nose of lemon & lime with floral nuances, joined on the palate by honey and brioche. An elegant Champagne full of complexity and finesse.

N.V. Perrier Jouët Grand Brut, Épernay

Established in 1811, Perrier-Jouët has been at the forefront of Champagne production for over 200 years, playing an integral role in developing the style of Champagne we enjoy today. The Grand Brut has an attractive bouquet, with youthful, delicate, creamy hints and a touch of yeasty autolysis. Lively persistent bubbles fill the mouth with clean, soft creamy fruit. An elegant and balanced champagne, with excellent intensity and a long, lingering finish.

N.V. Bollinger Special Cuvée, Reims

The nose is clean, rather reserved, showing gently polished fruit. Good structure to the palate, with a stylish definition around some good substance. A crisp mousse, fine, and good balance overall.

N.V. Ruinart Blanc de Blancs, Reims

The nose is full of aromas of white peach and almonds. The palate reveals powerful and complex flavours with an elegant finish.

N.V. Krug 'Grande Cuvée' Reims

Since 1843 the House of Krug has proudly cultivated the markedly individual character of their World renowned Champagne. A wonderfully creamy bouquet leads to a magical combination of weight and balance on the palate. The long, lingering finish is both nutty and toasty, ending with a final flourish of freshness.

N.V. Moutard Père et Fils *Prestige Rosé*

The Moutards can trace their wine growing history back centuries, and have been producing champagne under their own name since the 1920's. Their distinctive Prestige Rosé is both subtle and complex, with floral aromas leading to notes of wild strawberries and raspberries with hints of spice. A lively mousse and crisp fruity acidity keep the wine finely honed and balanced.

N.V. Laurent Perrier *Cuvée Rosé Brut, Reims*

Clean and wonderfully fresh, reminiscent of red and black fruit on the nose. On the tongue this refined Champagne is supple and elegant with a lingering finish.

N.V. Cava '+&+ Seleccion' Brut *Bodegas Pinord, Penedès, Spain*

The Tetas family of Bodegas Pinord have been producing wine for over 150 years and their name has become inseparably linked to quality Penedès wines- where over 95% of Cava is produced. The mild Mediterranean climate between Barcelona and Tarragona is ideal for growing vines, with evidence that even the Romans planted vineyards here. This elegant Cava spends 12 months on its lees (3 more than required by the D.O), lending it refreshing citrus notes, with richness from the Xarel-lo grape balanced by floral notes from the Parallada and Macabao. A sophisticated Cava that works equally well as an aperitif or when matched with seafood dishes.

N.V. Prosecco Extra Dry *Gocce di Favola, Veneto, Italy*
